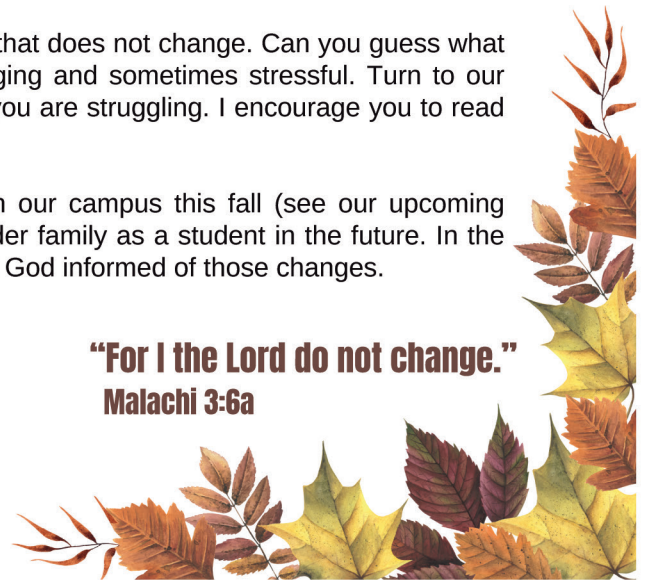

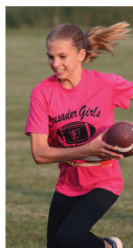
CRUSADER 2023 SUMMER CAMPS
