Involvement at LHS: Volleyball, choir

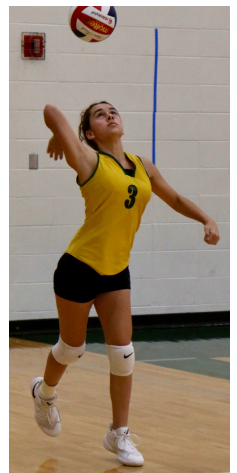
Favorite class at LHS: Science

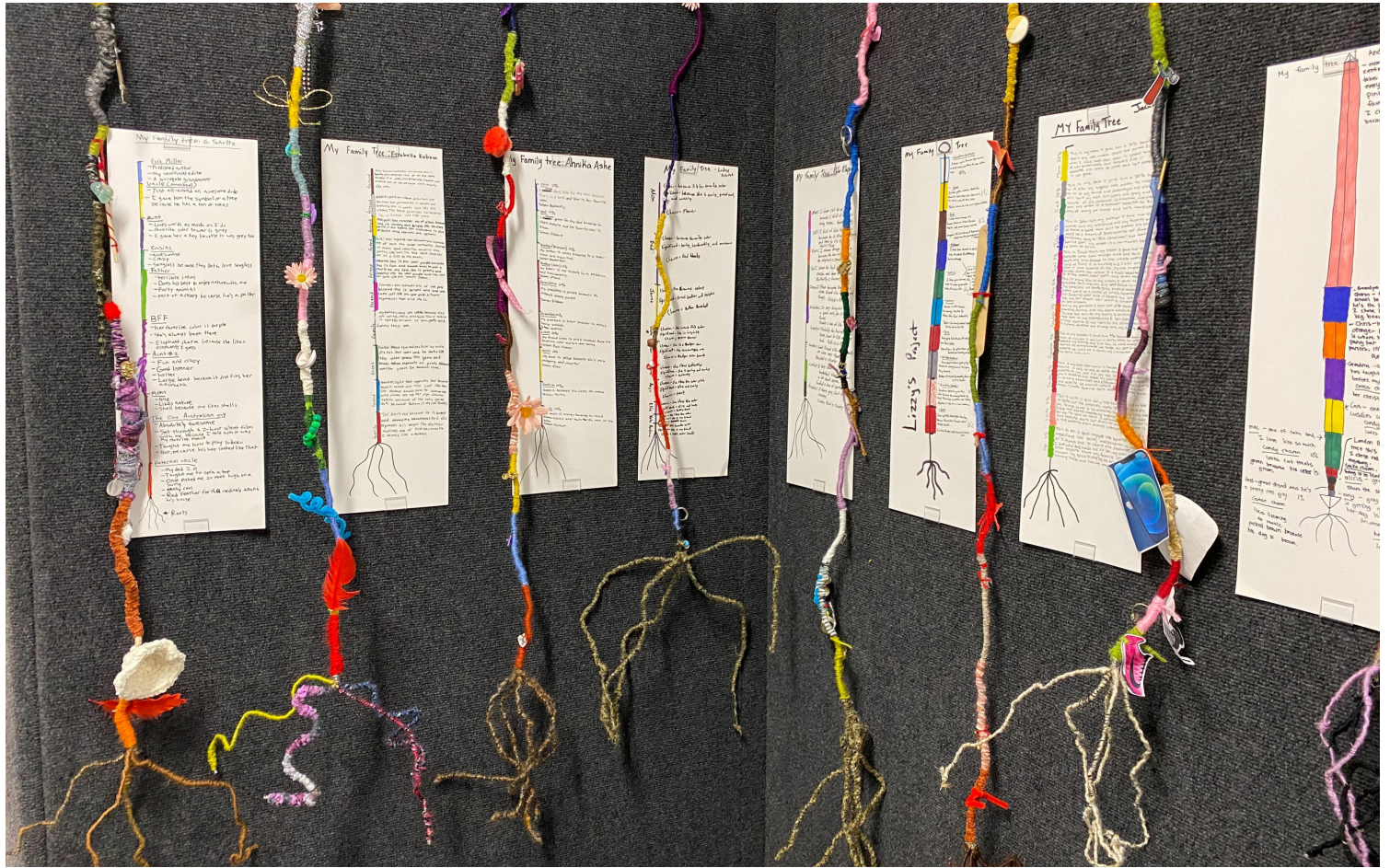
