Exam Guidelines

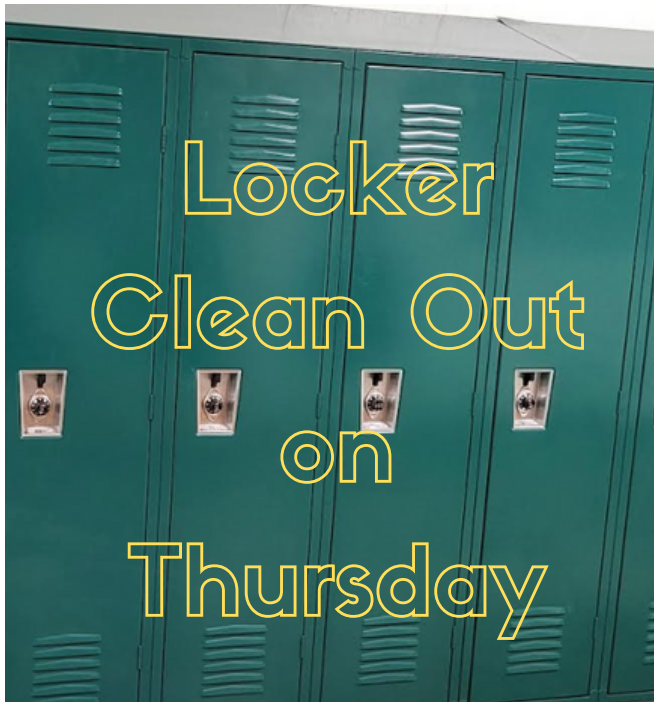
1. Dress code is "in effect."
