Jr. Crusader Basketball

Jr. Crusader Basketball Program

Jr. Crusaders is a youth basketball program that focuses on basketball fundamentals. Coaches will teach basic defensive and offense skills, terminology, and technique. Additionally, players will get to know each other and begin to build friendships on and off the court.



Who can participate in the Jr. Crusader Program?

The Jr. Crusader program is currently designed for boys in 3rd - 8th grade. All boys (SALSA and Non-SALSA) are encouraged to participate. The program is intended to support the Lutheran High School Boys Basketball programs.

Participants do not need to be committed to going to Lutheran High School; however, it is encouraged.

When is the Jr. Crusader Program offered?

The Jr. Crusader Program is set up to begin each year in October and end in April. The program is broken into two sessions: Fall Session (I) and Spring Session (II)

The Fall Session starts the first Sunday in October and ends the last Sunday in February (21 weeks). The Spring Session runs the first Sunday in March and ends the last Sunday in April (9 weeks). The Fall Session is focused on skill building and fundamentals. The Spring Session is designed to take learned skills to the court and is geared to more game and team action.

The Fall and Spring Sessions each offer participants 3 levels of involvement. A player and his parents can pick a level of involvement depending upon interest and commitment level.

How much does it cost to join the Jr. Crusader Program?

Each participant will be charged \$35 which includes: 20+ Sunday Sessions, lifetime friendships, and Summer Camp/AAU Program Review Session

Course cancellation and refund policy

Sheboygan Lutheran High School may find it necessary to cancel a specific summer program. When cancellation becomes necessary, those enrolled will be notified and a full refund of payments will be made.

REFUND POLICY:

1. If a registered student withdraws from a summer program, any refund due will be based on the date Lutheran High School receives notice of withdrawal:
 - Two weeks or more before the start of a program: Full refund.
 - Less than two weeks before the start of a program: 50% refund.
 - Day program starts or later: No refund.
2. Exceptions to the policy will normally be made only for documented injury or illness that prevents the individual from participating.
3. Following the start of a program, any refund for injury or illness will be prorated based on the days actually attended minus a \$10 administrative fee.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

Please register **NO LATER THAN TWO WEEKS** prior to the start of the camp. Late registration is available up until the day before the camp begins. Late registrants must pay an additional \$10 fee. Call the school office (452-3323) to confirm that space is still available in the camp of your choice.
