Thanks to all for all your hard work!

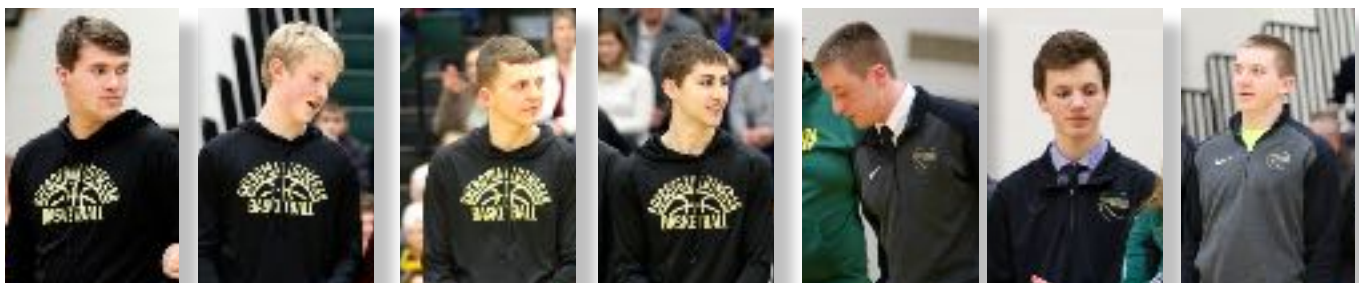

TUITION TIPS

Take advantage of Prepaid Tuition

Lutheran High's Prepaid Tuition program is a popular option for many families who intend to send their children or grandchildren to Lutheran High. In fact, many families prepay future tuition for multiple years for multiple children. You save dollars in the future by locking in at current tuition rates. When tuition goes up in the future, you owe nothing in addition to what you have already prepaid (not counting registration fee).

The Prepaid Tuition Form is located on our website at www.lutheranhigh.com. Click on the "Enroll Now" tab and then click on "Prepaid Tuition form." Make the decision for Lutheran High today that saves you money tomorrow.

Tax Deduction for Private School Tuition

Parents with a child in a private school are able to receive a tax deduction for tuition. Under the State of Wisconsin's program, parents statewide are able to deduct a percentage of tuition paid up to \$4,000 per student in grades K-8, and up to \$10,000 per high school student. Check with your accounting or financial advisor to determine your deduction. Schedule PS should be used with your return.

Early Registration – The non-refundable registration fee must accompany your completed re-enrollment paperwork. The early bird registration fee is \$300 and is due by April 16, 2018. If paid between April 16 – Aug. 1, the fee changes to \$450. After Aug. 1, the fee is \$550. Students will not be considered enrolled for the new school year until ALL their paperwork and the registration fee are returned to the office.

Choice Vouchers for LHS

The Statewide Wisconsin Parental Choice Program application period is Feb. 1- April 20 for the '18/'19 school year. This program is a statewide program that allows eligible families a choice to attend a private school in their area, tuition free. Families are eligible based on an income limit and residency verification. The WPCP voucher is selected through a random drawing of all applicants and pays the tuition and registration fees for the year. The application portal will be available on Feb. 1 and accessible from our website at www.lutheranhigh.com.

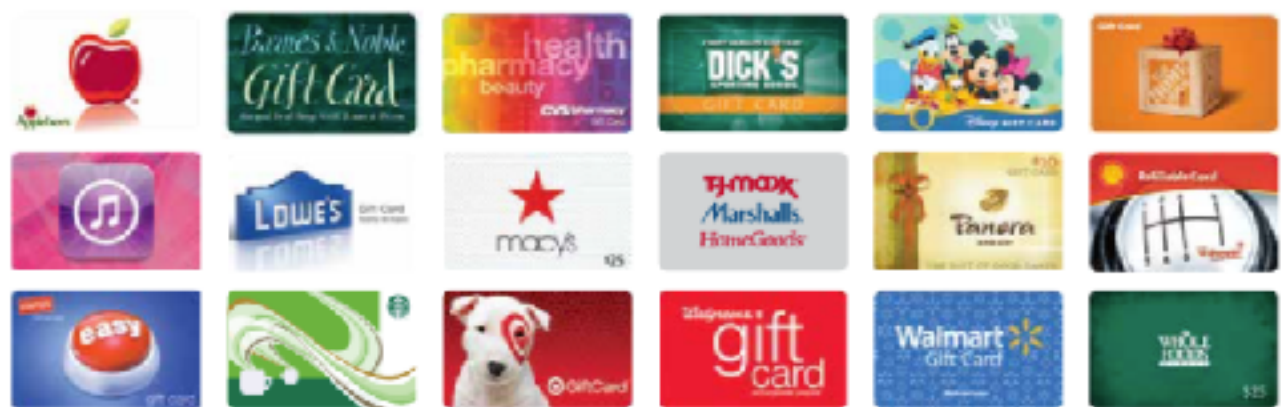

- The Scrip card program is one way you can put credit toward your registration fee or tuition.
- When you purchase Scrip cards, a portion of the dollars you are already spending for your daily needs will be credited back to you and it can be applied toward a child's tuition at LHS.
