Workbound Update - Report #3

Workbound helps to shape the future of our community's next generation of professionals through a unique, systematic approach that brings together students, parents, teachers and the business community. If we can assist in helping a student develop the skills and tools necessary to choose a career in which they can be successful, we have a better chance to recruit that young adult back to our community as a valuable and productive member of our local work force.

Each year, the Workbound Board of Directors awards one \$1,000 scholarship to a Workbound senior from each participating school. Criteria for receiving a scholarship includes successfully completing all tasks in the curriculum and attending all Workbound meetings and events over the two years of the program.

Workbound is a program free to the students. They student must agree to participate with their parent(s) and also find a personal advisor who will attend the four (4) meetings during his/her junior and senior year. Myrna Lastusky and Kym Leibham will be running the program at LHS.

During the 2010 school year, the Workbound meetings are scheduled for the evenings of the dates below:

Kym Leibham will be at Parent/Teacher Conferences on Monday, February 1st to provide parents with further details about the program and a formal letter will also be e-mailed to the home of all sophomores so families can consider if they would like to participate in Workbound during the 2010-2011 school year.

Early Registration - All students (including current freshmen through juniors) need to pay an annual registration fee for the 2010 - 2011 school year. The early registration fee is \$300 if paid by March 31st. Don't miss the opportunity to meet this deadline! If it is paid after March 31st, the fee goes to \$450 (after Aug. 1st \$550). This is a non-refundable fee which is in addition to your tuition. All students also need to complete a re-enrollment application form which is available on the Lutheran High website - www.lutheranhigh.com.

Financial Aid - Lutheran High has chosen Tuition Aid Data Services (TADS) to process and determine financial aid for our families. Applications for Student Aid can be picked up in the LHS office. The application deadline is February 28, 2010. There is a fee made payable to TADS that must accompany your application. Only TADS applicants are eligible for grant aid assistance.
