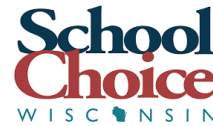

**School Choice Voucher Application Period opens Friday, Feb. 1:** The Statewide Wisconsin Parental Choice Program application period runs from now until April 20 for the '19/'20 school year. This program is a statewide program that allows eligible families a choice to attend a private school in their area, tuition free. The program is open to families with 8th graders applying to Lutheran High School as freshmen, or any student in 9-11 that would like to transfer here from a public school system, or students from a homeschool environment. Also, all families who currently hold vouchers must reapply on the WPCP website portal each year and verify their residency requirements.
