Basketball Season Passes, Preferred Seating, and Parking Spots

Lutheran High is selling **season ticket passes for both girls and boys basketball** seasons as well as **combo season ticket passes** (both girls and boys basketball season pass). Moreover, we will also be selling **preferred season ticket passes** (the cushioned seats with backrests in the first three rows) and, for the first time, **season parking passes**. We have 42 available preferred season passes and 20 parking spots (by the school's south wall) available for sale. We are anticipating rather large crowds and parking congestion during our winter boys basketball season this year. Thus, we wanted you to be aware of some of these options. Preferred Stadium Seating: Boys Season - \$80/person Girls Season - \$80/person

All Winter Boys and Girls Seasons - \$150/person Preferred Seating: Boys or Girls/Game - \$8/person

Admission Prices:

Boys Season - \$35/person Girls Season - \$35/person All Winter Basketball Pass - \$70/person

Preferred Parking: \$60/parking spot - Boys Basketball Season only

(Note: We need a minimum of ten to make this a go and a maximum of 20 parking spots to be sold.)
