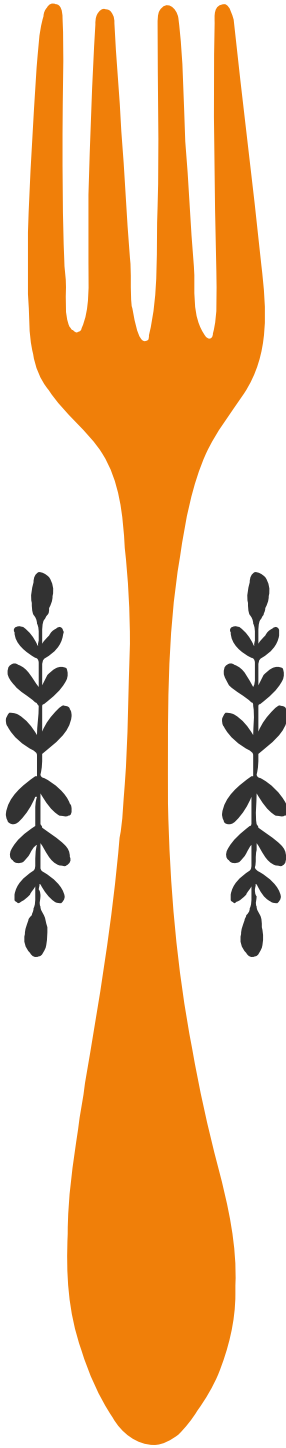
In celebration of our 40th Anniversary,

Exam Guidelines

1. Dress code is “in effect.”
2. Students will not be allowed to leave the room during the test time even if they are finished with the test. No corridor passes.
3. Semester exams will count for 20% of the semester grade.

5. Students do not have to report to school until their first test of the day and must remain in the building until their last test has been completed.
6. No make-up exams will be given unless approval is granted by the teacher and the Principal. Excuses for illness must be written “doctor excuses” or “detailed” written parent excuses.
