Student Fundraiser – The past six years the students have been involved in a school wide student fundraiser. The last 4 years we have sold cookie dough. We have been able to purchase many of the projectors that are mounted in each of the classrooms with this money. While grateful for the amount of money raised each year of the cookie dough and kringle sale, the funds raised have been slowly dwindling. This year we will be selling Crusader Cards. These cards include discounts at Highland House, Jimmy John's, The Depot, Schulz's Restaurant, MC Sports, and many more. **This will be kicked off on Nov. 14th during CMT.** We are going to give each student 10 cards to sell. The cards are \$20 each. When you see the card, you will see that this is a great value. The sale will continue through Nov. 28th giving the students time to sell Crusader Cards to their relatives and friends over the Thanksgiving Break. The money and remaining cards will be due on Monday, Nov. 28th. There will be prize incentives for the top sellers and the top class.

This year the money raised will be spent on three different items. We are having a school-wide fundraiser that involves filling shoeboxes with gifts for needy children all over the world. Most importantly, included with these boxes is the Gospel message in the children's native language.

GLOW is heading up the LHS branch of Operation Christmas Child. They will do the work of putting the boxes together and getting them ready for shipping. But we need everyone's help to gather the supplies; that's where you come in.

We're making this fundraiser a competition between all the 4th hour classes. Bring gifts to your 4th hour classroom, where there will be a box for all the items. If you don't have a chance to shop for some gifts, you can donate money to help defray shipping costs*. Every \$1 will count as an item. The class with the most items (divided by the number of students) will win a feast of delectable goodies. The competition begins Monday, Nov. 14th and ends Friday, Nov. 18th at 3:15 PM.

*Place any monetary donations in an envelope with the name of your 4th hour teacher on the front. Drop off envelopes of money in the school office.

**We also need shoeboxes! Bring any available shoeboxes (worth 1 pt) to the Guidance Office. Plastic containers (worth 3 pts.) are also great, as the recipients can re-use them for storage and other uses.

Gift Ideas - *Appropriate for boys & girls aged 2-14. Think SMALL! It all must fit in a shoebox!*

Toys: Small cars, balls, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, small Etch-a-Sketch, toys that light up or make noise (w/extra batteries), Slinky, etc.

School Supplies: Pens, pencils and sharpener, crayons or markers, stamps and ink pad sets, writing pads or paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.

Hygiene Items: Toothbrush, toothpaste, mild bar soap (in a plastic bag), comb, washcloth, etc.

Other: Hard candy and lollipops (**please double-bag all candy**), mints, gum, t-shirts, socks, ball caps, sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry, watches, flashlights (w/extra batteries).

A Personal Note: In a separate envelope, you may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or your family. (If you include your name and address, the child may write back). We will distribute any letters we receive among the boxes that are sent.

DO NOT INCLUDE: Used or damaged items, war-related items, such as toy guns, knives or military figures, chocolate or food; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers, aerosol cans.
