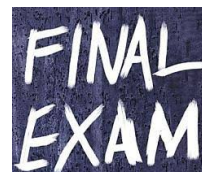

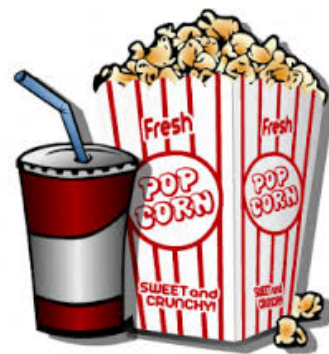


News from Neat Repeats:
