**Early Registration** - All students (including current freshmen through juniors) need to pay an annual registration fee for the 2010 - 2011 school year. The early registration fee is \$300 if paid by March 31st. Don’t miss the opportunity to meet this deadline! If it is paid after March 31st, the fee goes to \$450 (after Aug. 1st \$550). This is a non-refundable fee which is in addition to your tuition. **Financial Aid** - Lutheran High has chosen Tuition Aid Data Services (TADS) to process and determine financial aid for our families. Applications for Student Aid can be picked up in the LHS office. The application deadline is February 28, 2010. There is a fee made payable to TADS that must accompany your application. Only TADS applicants are eligible for grant aid assistance.
