FAFSA Workshop - This free workshop will be held at **Lutheran High on Wednesday, February 10th**. Drop in anytime between 4:00 - 7:00 PM in the computer lab. You will receive free hands-on help filling out the FAFSA form. If possible, bring the following items along: Social Security number, Driver's license or equivalent, 2009 federal tax returns (students & parents), 2008 federal tax returns if 2009 returns are not complete (students & parents), 2009 untaxed income records (students & parents), 2009 bank statements (students and/or parents), 2009 business and investment records (students & parents), and alien registration card if you are not a U.S. citizen. Bring what you can, but even if you're missing something, the workshop provides important information that will help you get the money you need for college.

Early Registration - All students (including current freshmen through juniors) need to pay an annual registration fee for the 2010 - 2011 school year. The early registration fee is \$300 if paid by March 31st. Don't miss the opportunity to meet this deadline! If it is paid after March 31st, the fee goes to \$450 (after Aug. 1st \$550). This is a non-refundable fee which is in addition to your tuition. All students also need to complete a re-enrollment application form which is available on the Lutheran High website - www.lutheranhigh.com.

Financial Aid - Lutheran High has chosen Tuition Aid Data Services (TADS) to process and determine financial aid for our families. Applications for Student Aid can be picked up in the LHS office. The application deadline is February 28, 2010. There is a fee made payable to TADS that must accompany your application. Only TADS applicants are eligible for grant aid assistance.
