Semester Exam Guidelines

1. Dress code is "in effect."
2. Students will not be allowed to leave the room during the test time even if they are finished with the test. No corridor passes unless it is an emergency!
3. Semester exams will count for 20% of the semester grade.
4. Students in the building who are not taking a test will be in the study hall.
5. Students do not have to report to school until their first test of the day and must remain in the building until their last test has been completed.
6. No make-up exams will be given unless approval is granted by the teacher and the Principal. Excuses for illness must be written "doctor excuses" or "detailed" written parent excuses.
7. **It is very important that students are not late for the start of each exam!**
