## A Good Reminder from Vince

Winning isn't everything, it's the only thing," is the alleged quote most often recited and associated with the legendary Green Bay Packer coach, Vince Lombardi. The quote, however, that means the most to me from the life of Vince Lombardi are the words he shared with each of his teams on the first day of practice. Vince would stand before his team, hold up a football and with his commanding voice say: "Gentlemen, this is a football." (Of course, each year some wise-guy player like Paul Horning would respond: "Hold on coach, you're going too fast for us.")

Vince Lombardi had a way of keeping things simple and clear. He did not complicate matters. Indeed, constantly reminding his players about the overall objectives of the game—to get the football in the end zone when on offense and keep it out of the end zone when on defense—Vince enables his players to concentrate and focus on how they would achieve their goal.

Lutheran High is entering the second half of our season or school year. Our students have experienced a semester's worth of course work, athletic contests, musical performances, servant projects, quizzes and tests, homework and special projects, social challenges and joys, affirmations, temptations, and so much more. Other high school students, however, experience these same things too.

What makes Lutheran High different is that we keep it simple. We remain focused on Preparing Christian Leaders—One Student at a Time. We have no trick plays or gadget playbook. Our most important focus is having our students listen and respond to their Savior every day.

Indeed, our students attend chapel twice a week and theology class daily. Our teachers—in all fields of study—integrate God's Word and Truth in every unit, in every lesson. Lutheran High teachers actually evaluate and assess our students on their Christian leadership walk and growth. We talk about what it means to be a Christian servant leader daily. Moreover, our faculty and staff are very conscientious on what it means to not just model the love of Christ, but embrace and teach the love of Christ. This also means that when we sin and make mistakes, we repent, confess, and receive the grace of Jesus Christ anew.

In the spirit of Vince Lombardi's clarity, please treasure the fact that Lutheran High teachers stand before their students each and every day and point to the cross saying: "Boys and girls, this is your Savior, Jesus Christ. He died for you and has forgiven you all of your sins. Serve joyfully and purposely in His name. Jesus truly is the only thing that matters in life."
