The event will begin at 9:30am with registration and check-in starting at 8am. Event t-shirts will be guaranteed with early registration by July 30th. They will be available to other participants while supplies last. Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each age group and to the overall male and female winners. Following the race, a brat fry will be held which will also benefit the MACC Fund. The \$15 entry fee covers the cost of the t-shirt and the race.
