Dear LHS Families, Students, and Community,

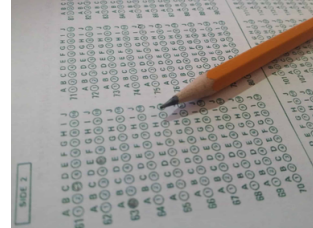

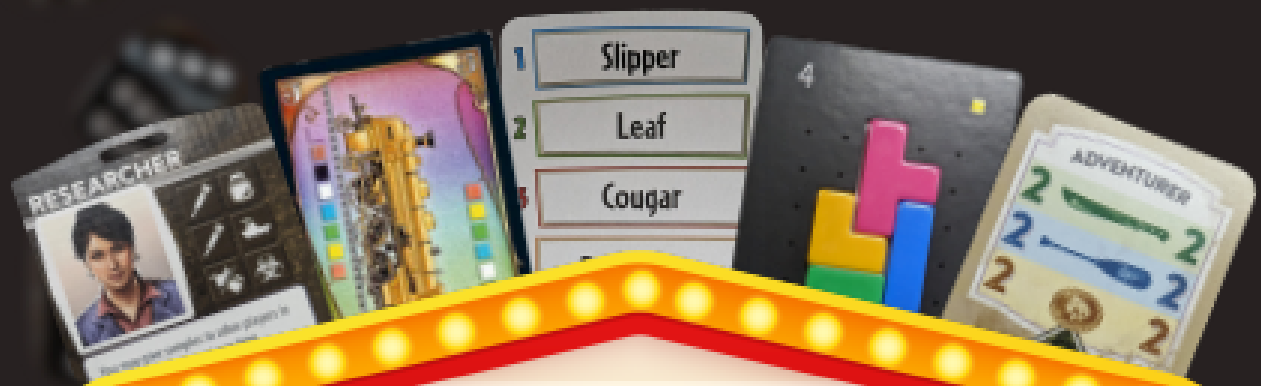
