

## AVENUES TO EXPLORE

### WI PARENTAL CHOICE VOUCHER:

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program allows parents to receive a voucher to enroll their children in private and religious schools, and **covers 100% of tuition and registration fees**. The statewide program is available to those families with incomes below 220% of the federal poverty level. The vouchers are awarded by a random lottery. The deadline for applying online is the third Thursday in April.

### SCRIP:

Simply by using SCRIP cards to pay for your normal weekly purchases, you can put money toward your tuition or direct it to benefit LHS. Over 300 local and nation-wide products and services offer a percentage back that you can bank and use for tuition and registration fees at LHS.

### 529 PLANS:

The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act, which was signed into law in December 2017, allows families to use 529 plans to pay for up to \$10,000 in tuition expenses at K-12 private or parochial schools. The changes became effective January 1, 2018. Check with your tax or investment professional for more advise on using a 529 plan.

### PREPAID TUITION:

Lutheran High has a program that makes it possible for parents, grandparents, or guardians to pre-pay for their child's tuition at Lutheran High while **locking in at current tuition rates**. This has become a popular option for many parents.

### TUITION ASSISTANCE:

Lutheran High School's financial aid dollars come from our Leaders for Life Endowment. This endowment is an investment of money from many donors for many years. It is vital as our main stream of what LHS can offer to families in need.

### NAMED SCHOLARSHIPS:

LHS has several scholarships designated annually to students who align with the family's wishes such as:

**Katherine Marie Immel Memorial Scholarship** - established in 2009 to honor the memory of 2002 LHS graduate, Katie Immel. This scholarship exists to assist a student with financial need who understands the importance of excelling in the classroom and balances that with the growth opportunity that participation in extracurricular activities can bring.

**John and LaVerne Hermann Memorial Scholarship** - established in 1980 to honor the memory of John, an original founder. Later it included his wife, LaVerne, who continued John's early vision in providing financial support. This scholarship exists for students who have financial need with an emphasis on being awarded to those families who will have more than one from the same family attending Lutheran High.

**Charles Benedum Student Mentor Endowment** - established to honor Chuck Benedum for his years of service to LHS as a teacher, athletic director and volunteer. This award provides aid to students with financial need and a desire to serve, study, and fully participate as a student at Lutheran High.

**Emily Hughes Memorial Scholarship** - established in 2011 to honor the memory of 2008 LHS graduate, Emily Hughes. This scholarship provides tuition assistance to a Catholic family with financial need.

**Heidi G. Hake Scholarship** - established to honor the memory of 1983 LHS graduate, Heidi Hake. This award provides aid to students with financial need that value the importance of Christ-centered education and participation in extracurricular activities.

### APPLYING FOR TUITION ASSISTANCE THROUGH 'TADS':

Tuition assistance and scholarship dollars including the above Named Scholarships are awarded each year based on demonstrated financial need and aid dollars available. Need is determined annually through the completion of the TADS aid online application. Scholarship eligibility is determined after your TADS application is complete. The deadline is the end of February each year.

TADS is a private independent service that LHS uses to help determine aid awards.
