Dear Crusader Family,

We are pleased to announce LHS is handling re-enrollment a bit differently this year. All re-enrollment will be handled **ONLINE!** There will be no more paper forms to fill out and return. To re-enroll your Crusader(s) for the 2025-2026 school year:

- Go to lutheranhigh.powerschool.com.



- The **username** is the email address you provided to LHS. Unsure which email address to use? Contact Mrs. Walecka at walecka@lutheranhigh.com.
- The **password** is Lutheran2025. After initially entering this, you will be prompted to create a unique password for your account.

- Once you are logged into PowerSchool, please notice your current student(s) in the top blue bar. **You will need to complete the following steps for EACH student you are re-enrolling:**
 - Click 'Forms' in the left navigation menu.
 - Verify that all information is accurate and up-to-date in the following forms. You can make any necessary updates directly in the form. Once each form has been verified/updated, click 'Submit' in the lower right:
 - A. Student Demographics
 - D. Student Contacts
 - E. Health Information
- Two forms require completion annually, at every re-enrollment period. Please complete the following forms and click 'Submit' for each one:
 - B. Financial Agreement
 - Please note you will be prompted to pay the **annual re-enrollment fee** in this form (unless you are continuing in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program, through which this fee is not applicable). You can choose to pay by cash, check, or credit card. The re-enrollment fee schedule is outlined below.
 - F. Permissions/Agreements
- The following forms are intended for new applicants only. **You can skip these for re-enrollment:**
 - C. Current Enrollment and Records Release
 - G. Parent Questionnaire

Once Forms A, B, D, E, and F have been submitted and your application fee has been received, your child is officially re-enrolled for the 2025-2026 school year!

Re-enroll early to SAVE on re-enrollment fees!

- \$325 if paid by January 31
- \$375 if paid by February 28
- \$425 if paid by March 31
- \$475 if paid by April 30
- \$525 if paid by May 31
- \$575 if paid June 1 or later
